The Sustainable Forestry Initiative Standard (SFIS) is a comprehensive set of principles, objectives and performance measures developed by professional foresters, conservationists and scientists, among others, that combines the perpetual growing and harvesting of trees with the long-term protection of wildlife, plants, soil, and water quality. In short, it defines how companies will manage forests with respect to economic, social and environmental factors.

SFI Certification by a third party helps to assure the public and consumers that Kalesnikoff Lumber Company Ltd. is committed to managing their forest lands in a sustainable and environmentally sound manner.



The SFI Program is endorsed by the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification schemes. The PEFC sets minimum benchmarks for national forest certification systems worldwide and endorses schemes that meet or exceed those requirements. (www.pefc.org)
